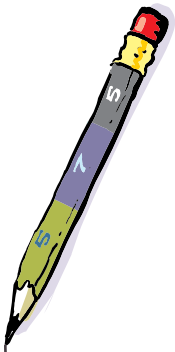
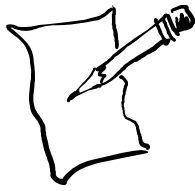


How to Guyku
